My name is Ferenc Somogyi, I was born on the 28th of October, in Inke (Somogy County).

I have received a degree in business economics in 1980, from the Faculty of Business and Economics, University of Pécs.

In 1982, I have received my second degree as an economics teacher on the Karl Marx University of Economic Sciences.

I have accomplished my PhD on the Faculty of Business and Economics University of Pécs in 1983. The title of my dissertation is: The problematics of ownership and interests of economic associations in the food industry.

In 1995, I have defended my candidate paper on the Karl Marx University of Economic Sciences, titled: The evolutionary perspectives of the mixed economy.

Between 1980 and 2020, I have been teaching in numerous institutes of higher education (Szeged, Veszprém, Székesfehérvár, Győr), I have had several subjects in economics (including: macro- and microeconomics, international economics, the theoretic history of economics, environmental economics, business ethics, ecological economy, economic policy).

On two research fields (the state of Hungarian human capital, the social and economic evolutionary perspectives of the XXI. century), I have written 15 books, scholarly books for students, and approximately 150 of scholarly articles of mine have been published.
